**Discussion: Next Steps:** The Commission and Dr. Sommers discussed next steps in the data transformation process. Dr. Curry said that the committee would discuss this further.

**Presentation: Innovation Example by Khan Academy:** Dr. Ed Harris (in person) and Salman Khan (via Zoom) presented Khan Academy’s AI tutoring/teaching assistant platform, Khanmigo.
