**FY 2010 S.T.O.P. Violence Against Women Grant Awards**

The purpose of the S.T.O.P. Violence Against Women Grant is to encourage law enforcement, prosecution, and the courts to develop and implement effective victim-centered strategies to address violent crimes against women. In addition, the S.T.O.P. VAWA Program promotes the development and/or enhancement of victim services for intervention with victims of violent crimes. A requirement of the grant is that 30% of the funds must go for victims' services. In addition, ten percent (10%) of the 30% of the victim service funds must go to a culturally specific community based program. Twenty-five (25%) must go to law enforcement, 25% for prosecution, 5% for the courts and 15% is discretionary. In Oklahoma, these funds are generally awarded to programs that have a statewide impact.
