Andrea Hamor Edmondson, MA, CDSVRP, coordinates the Rape Prevention Education Program at the Oklahoma State Department of Health. Andrea has been an advocate for preventing violence for more than 15 years and for the last 8, has been part of a movement to help change the culture of Oklahoma to reject domestic and sexual violence. She is responsible for developing, implementing, and evaluating community-based and statewide sexual violence prevention programs and is an author of the Oklahoma Strategic Plan to End Sexual Violence. Andrea has presented in communities and at both state and national conferences on intimate partner, sexual, and teen dating violence and has published in peer-reviewed journals and magazines. She has served as a member of the Oklahoma Prevention Leadership Committee, the Domestic Fatality Review Board, the Oklahoma Justice Commission, and is the Chair-Elect of the RPE Director's Council.

Sheila Johnson is a registered nurse with more than 20 years' experience. She also performs Sexual Nurse Examiner exams in several counties in southeastern Oklahoma. Sheila is active in several Multi-disciplinary teams and coordinated community response teams along with education law enforcement, local community nursing programs, and other entities about sexual assault and domestic violence.
