#### F. **Building Permits**:

1. Discussion and possible action regarding B0-16-17-35, Request by Ron McCrory to construct an addition to the rear of the two-car garage at 704 NE 16<sup>th</sup> Street in the Howes Capitol Addition in Oklahoma City, OK (variance required).

The current garage is only 17' deep and makes it difficult for a modern vehicle to park in. The proposed addition is 20' wide by 8', 9" deep to the rear of the existing two-car garage. The reason for the variance is the rules allow for 30% lot coverage in an R-2 district. The addition would put it over 1.9%.
