FY08 Closing Dates

This year, we are extending the closing date to give agencies more time to prepare & send requisitions for state funded projects as follows:

- **May 1, 2008** - FY 2008 Requisitions for publicly bid construction projects over \$50,000.00 estimated cost.  
Incomplete bid documents may delay and not allow contract award on time.
- **June 1, 2008** – FY2008 Requisitions for projects \$50,000.00 and below -three letterhead quotes needed.  
Please provide vendor's insurance with the requisition and inform recommended bidder of the urgency of signing and returning contract documents. Documents may need to be hand carried by the Using Agency or vendor for signatures.

Due to the number of contracts that we will handle from now until the end of the fiscal year, we request that your agency start processing requisitions for FY 2008 as soon as possible. If you have multiple projects, please stagger them out if you can. Now is the time to start work on those projects that need to be completed by our division before the end of June, 2008.

Please make sure all drawings and specifications are complete. Incomplete specifications or drawings, proprietary bids, sole source specifications or those prepared by vendors may delay the start of your project. If you have questions, please call us at 521-2112. CAP will be happy to assist you in the preparation of these documents.

If a consultant is required to prepare the drawings and specifications and has not been selected, please start the selection process immediately.

Requisitions for FY 2009 can also be received at this time. Please mark the requisitions in **RED** with the word **"NEW"** so that they can be readily separated from FY 2008.

#### Contract Renewal Reminder

Effective July 1, 2007 a fee of \$100.00 will be charged for each annual renewal for Multi-Year Service Contracts. Please remember to send a Purchase Order for this fee with your renewal request. If you choose to cancel your contract, please notify CAP in writing no less than 40 days before the end of the current time period on the contract. #### Solicitation Advertisement Procedure change

Beginning December 1, 2007 the Construction & Properties division is accepting invoices directly from the publications that advertise Solicitations for Bid. Previously the publications invoiced the Using Agency directly. CAP will pay the publications for the advertisement and then invoice the appropriate Using Agency for reimbursement. This will ensure that all advertising invoices are paid on time.
