Dear Dealer Partners,

As discussed in our Dealer Town Hall earlier this morning, the entire industry has been subject to an unprecedented number of economic challenges over the past 20+ months. Unrelenting and prolonged turbulent economic conditions have resulted in skyrocketing material and component costs, increased labor wages, rising fuel prices, higher logistics rates and the highest rate of inflation in over three decades.

Daimler Truck North America (DTNA) and our parent company Daimler Truck AG, have worked tirelessly to mitigate the effect of increased commodity and supply chain related costs to you, our valued dealer partners, and our mutual customers to date. However, these continued challenging economic conditions have made it necessary for our company to implement a pricing surcharge on all MY23 Freightliner & Western Star trucks (details below). Increases are in addition to the \$300 MY23 Product Cost Surcharge announced earlier this year.

• All MY23 units (excluding trucks rolled from CY21 to the first quarter) will be subject to the additional non-discountable surcharge below:

- The Total MY23 Surcharge fee applies to all trucks included in your CY22 Dealer Reservation System plan, including both Program and Concession reservations.
- The total non-discountable surcharge will be presented as a single line item on the truck invoice.
- Dealers are responsible to update and include Total MY23 Surcharge on all current and future quotes for CY22/MY23.
- Dealers are responsible to notify customers of the total MY23 surcharge effective immediately.
- Total MY23 Surcharge is in addition to all previous CY22 Surcharges announced by DTNA including FCCC for the Tire Surcharge, DD13 Gen 5, CARB22, Standard Destination & Freight, etc.

#### Order Cancellation Policy:

- All units ordered as true MY23 (excluding trucks that were rolled from 2021 to 2022) can be cancelled at N/C by Dec 22, 2021.
- All cancelled orders will be subtracted from your plan volumes and returned to Freightliner and Western Star.

Standard Destination Charges - effective May 3, 2021

Standard Destination charges have not been changed since Q4 2018. Factors that influence these charges include: transporter base rates, driver costs, fuel, fuel taxes, production mix, delivery locations and load factor. Based on recent analysis of these factors, we are increasing our standard destination charge by \$250 to cover the increase in cost and modifying our Customer Pick-up Policy as follows:

<u>Destination Charge - Freightliner Models</u>: Effective May 3, 2021, and through Q3 2021, the Standard Destination Charge will be \$2,450 net (non-discountable) for U.S. and Canadian dealers.

Revised Customer Pick-up (CPU) Policy: Effective May 3, 2021, the current \$250 admin fee will be replaced with a fixed \$1,000 credit to the current published Standard Destination Charge.

All vehicles with an **order receipt date** on or after May 3, 2021, will be invoiced at the new published rate.

**4Q2021 Destination Charges**: We will send a notice in September with the 4Q2021 standard destination charges.

Standard Destination Charges - effective September 2, 2021

Due to increased logistics costs, ongoing supply chain constraints, driver shortages, and higher fuel prices, Freightliner is increasing our standard destination charge by \$250 to cover the increase in cost as follows:

<u>Destination Charge - Freightliner Models</u>: Effective September 2, 2021, and through Q4 2021, the Standard Destination Charge will be \$2,700 net (non-discountable) for U.S. and Canadian dealers.

<u>Customer Pick-up (CPU) Policy:</u> There is no change to the fixed \$1,000 credit to the current published Standard Destination Charge CPU Policy which has been in effect since May 3, 2021.

All vehicles with an <u>order receipt date</u> on or after September 2, 2021, will be invoiced at the new published rate.

**1Q2022 Destination Charges**: We will send a notice in December with the 1Q2022 standard destination charges.

CY22 Tire Surcharges - effective September 23, 2021

DTNA is receiving cost increases from all tire manufacturers for calendar year 2022.

Effective on September 23, 2021 all orders manufactured after January 4, 2022 will incur a net/net tire surcharge. This surcharge will be in effect for production of all model year 2023 vehicles.

These surcharges will automatically be applied to all orders that are scheduled to be built in calendar year 2022 and are applicable to all price levels. These specific codes and amounts will be published in SpecPro on 9/23/21.

Standard Truck Change Order policy for any spec changes applies.

The per tire surcharge applies to the quantity of each module: 093 front tires 094 rear tires 095 pusher or tag tires

510 spare tires

508 additional spare tire

CY21 Pricing Notice:

New Cummins X12, L9 and B6.7 Engines

Cummins B6.7, L9, X12, and X15 engines with a chassis start date of January 04, 2021 and beyond require GHG21 compliance. The existing Cummins L9 and B6.7 engines will be replaced and any truck specifications with the above engines with a chassis start date of January 04, 2021 and beyond will be forced through compatibility to the new engine/ATS offering.

This is a required product change-over and the following net non-discountable price escalator(s), will apply to account for the increase Cummins passed along to DTNA:

- L9 \$510
- B6.7 \$455
- X12 \$450

The price increase will be reflected as a net escalator and not in the engine option pricing in SpecPro.

These changes are tied to the <u>data code 99C-021</u> which indicates GHG21 compliance which requires a January 1, 2021 and beyond requested delivery date. This combination of attributes will ensure that the retail option pricing and this net escalator on your SpecPro file will correctly reflect what will be on the invoice.
