## For Providers

MyHealth Access Network links more than 4,000 providers and their patients in a community-wide health information system that will help providers better monitor and improve care to:

- Improve care coordination during transitions between health care settings
- Enhance patients' experience and ability to take control of their own health

### PROVIDER PORTAL

The MyHealth Provider Portal allows users to securely and instantly access patient's health information from more than 1,500 locations. Our master person index links records for the same patient across multiple organizations.

### SINGLE SIGN-ON

Single Sign-On seamlessly integrates access to the MyHealth Provider Portal with the user's EMR, allowing them to transition with a single click and view the same patient across platforms effortlessly.

### CARE FRAGMENTATION ALERTING

Care Fragmentation Alerting notifies and provides providers visibility into when their patients receive care in Emergency Rooms, Hospitals, or other clinics in the past 24 hours. Helping providers to reduce 30 day remission, maximize follow-up revenue, close loops on referrals, guide care management activities, and succeed in Value Based Payment Models.

### CARE GAP REPORTING

Aids providers in identifying and addressing gaps in patient care by presenting the most recent values based on the provider's specified valueset, enabling targeted interventions for enhanced patient outcomes.

### SOCIAL NEEDS SCREENING

A mobile screening process to identify a patients health-related social needs and provide a custom list of resources to help address the identified needs. This process provides a valuable service to the patient with no additional workload for the healthcare facility.

### MYHEALTH E-NOTIFICATION (COP)

MyHealth E-Notifications help hospitals to comply with CMS Hospital Conditions of Participation (CoP) Electronic Notification requirement, hospitals must send an electronic notification to a patient's providers when patients are admitted, discharged, or transferred (ADT) from the hospital.

## For Patients

If you have ever had to fill out the same form several times, or new forms with the same information, you've experienced the need for information sharing between doctors. Because patients may see several different physicians besides their primary care provider, different sets of medical records for the same patient can be found in different offices. MyHealth makes it possible to:

- Avoid completing annoying paperwork every time you visit a care provider
- Improve patient safety and outcomes when providers can make informed decisions about diagnosis and treatment with access to your medical history
- Stop paying for and receiving redundant tests
- No longer be prescribed medication you are allergic to or are already taking
- Receive consistent care no matter where you go for treatment, including emergency situations
