SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR PETITIONS TO NOMINATE BOARD MEMBERS

DATE: FEBRUARY 19, 2016

The State Board of Dentistry is requesting nominations for upcoming elections for the positions of Districts 6, 7, and 8. Each term is a 3-year term. District 6 comprises of Lincoln, Cleveland, Pottawatomie, Seminole, Okfuskee, Hughes, Pontotoc, Coal, Johnston, Marshall, and Bryan counties. District 7 comprises of Mayes, Wagoner, Cherokee, Adair, Okmulgee, Muskogee, Sequoyah, McIntosh, Haskell, Pittsburg, Latimer, LeFlore, Atoka, Pushmataha, Choctaw, and McCurtain counties. District 8 comprises of Osage, Payne, Washington, Nowata, Craig, Ottawa, Rogers, Delaware, and Pawnee counties.

The State Dental Act requires all written nominations be on a petition, signed by at least ten (10) dentists residing in the district of the nominee. For the purposes of the election, the residing county is the primary legal address of the Dentist as listed by the Oklahoma State Board of Dentistry. To be eligible to be elected to and serve on the Board, a Dentist must have been licensed to practice in this state for at least five (5) years prior to the date of counting ballots, not have been subject to a penalty imposed by the Board or its predecessor board.

All original petitions for nominations to be placed on a ballot must be returned personally or by certified mail to the Executive Director, 2920 N. Lincoln Blvd., Ste. B, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 by the 26th day of February 2016 no later than 4:30 p.m.. Ballots will be mailed to those entitled to vote on March 11th, 2016. All ballots must be received by the Board of Dentistry office by April 14th, 2016 by 4:30p.m. These ballots will be opened at the regular Board meeting on April 15th, 2016.
