

## Oklahoma Department of Corrections Retirement Sidearm and Badge Issue

Per Oklahoma State Statute 74:319 Section 150.23, Probation and Parole officers and/or Inspector General agents are entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason of length of service, the continued custody and possession of the sidearm and badge carried by such officer or agent immediately prior to retirement. Correctional Officers shall be entitled to receive, upon retirement by reason of length of service, the continued custody and possession of the badge carried by such officer prior to retirement.
