Pursuant to 22 O.S. §1115.5 (A)(2), the Department of Public Safety, Driver Compliance Division, may decline to initiate a request to suspend if the request is discovered to be improper or questionable. The issue DPS has with your request attached hereto is that DPS is unable to determine from your description of the violation on the request for suspension whether or not said violation is a misdemeanor violation of a state traffic law or municipal traffic ordinance. Accordingly, DPS requests the following attestation or certification from the submitting court clerk concerning the request for suspension. **WARNING:** In order to process your request for suspension, the completed Court Clerk Attestation or Certification must be received by DPS within 120 days of the date of violation.
