**Description of Amendment:**

- a. The following questions were asked. Answers are indicated next to each question

**Q:** Please rank which features by importance so we can pick a suit.

**A:**

- Suit shall be constructed of chemically resistant materials, such as butyl rubber, vulcanized rubber, or equivalent.
- Our suits are regularly exposed to motor vehicle fuels and oils, including an occasional jet fuel exposure
- Bidder shall provide, upon request, a summary of chemical permeation resistance test results as conducted in accordance with ASTM F 739
- Suit shall be designed and constructed with a high resistance to puncture and abrasion.
- Typically accomplished with laminate materials with protective outer layer, and additional protection at knees and elbows
- Vehicle, boat and plane recoveries necessitate this specification as they typically involve torn metal, broken fiberglass and other hazards that can be detrimental to a suit.
- Neck and wrist seals should be field serviceable to minimize downtime due to worn or torn seals.
- Suit to include:
  - o Heavy soled boots - integrated or non-integrated
  - o attachable latex hood and gloves.
  - o Front entry zipper - common feature, preferred but not mandatory
  - o Telescoping torso - common feature, preferred but not mandatory
  - o Swivel inlet valve - common feature
  - o Adjustable exhaust valve - common feature
- Suit shall be of a mainstream manufacturer.

**Additional Information:**

- o Bidder should have prior experience with first responders in the design and durability of the suit.
