The Oklahoma Highway Patrol is seeking information from wireless providers on a solution for the three southeastern Oklahoma counties of Choctaw, Pushmataha and McCurtain. The Oklahoma Highway Patrol is asking wireless providers that can provide both voice and data coverage to provide information for testing.

The OHP is seeking (2) Samsung Galaxy S5 wireless devices protected inside the Otter Box Commuter series that has the ability of activating a hot spot data connection from the device. Troopers that patrol these three counties would test the devices with the activated hot spot feature providing data to the troopers in-car computer.

The provider would allow the device to be tested with unlimited data and voice calls for the 20 day test period. Providers who desire to participate in this testing should respond by March 21st, 2016 at 5:00 pm.

The OHP desires to begin testing on March 28, 2016 and conclude the testing April 17, 2016.
