Determination of Quorum and Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:00pm. Ms. Hall called the roll. Board members present were Ms. Tracy Grammer, Dr. Mary Hudson, Dr. Greg A. Krempf, and Ms. Susan McHugh. A quorum was present.

Others present: Amy Hall, Executive Secretary and Sandra Balzer, Assistant Attorney General and guests; Mona Ryan.

Approval of Minutes from February 27, 2015 Board Meeting

Dr. Krempf moved and Ms. McHugh seconded the motion to approve the February 27 board meeting minutes as written. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Ms. McHugh, and Dr. Krempf voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Ms. McHugh moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion that numbers 1-17 with the exception of number 14, complaint 14-01 have all complied with the continuing education portion of the consent order and to dismiss the complaints. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempf, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Ms. Grammer abstained. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action on results of audit of licensees for continuing education hours for 2013-2014.

Ms. Hall reported on the 2013-2014 continuing education audit. Eighty six (86) licensees were audited for continuing education from our database of over 2,198 licensees. Of the 86 audited, 3 licensees CEU's were in question, 2 licensees sent in no documentation, 7 were short the required hours and 7 licensees did not claim their certified letters for the audit.

Dr. Krempf moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion that on tab 5 of agenda starting with Shari Anderson through page two to Lindsey Smith have all met the CEU audit requirements. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempf, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Motion approved.

Dr. Krempf moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to table the audit of CEU's for Rusty Willhoite for further review. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempf, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Motion approved.

Ms. McHugh moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to approve the CEU hours for Kelli Woods. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempf, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Motion approved.

Dr. Krempf moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to send certified letters to Kristy Haynes through Starla Wittrock from tab 5 of agenda list whose continuing education documents were not sufficient or did not complete the continuing education (CE) hours for the 2013-2014 audit. The letter gives the licensee 90 days from receipt of the letter to provide evidence of the CE hours; licensees can provide proof of hours short during 2013-2014 and pay a fine of \$42.50 or complete the hours needed during the 90 days and pay a fine of \$42.50. If the board has not received the documentation of continuing education and the fee in the allotted time, the board will take disciplinary action against the licensee. Any CE hours accrued during the 90-day period may not count toward the 2015-2016 continuing education requirements. The failure to comply with the 2013-2014 audit results in an automatic CE audit for 2015-2016 period. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempf, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Motion approved.

Dr. Krempf moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to table the audit and give additional notice by regular mail and email to Denise Barrett through Alexis Tompkins from tab 5 of agenda. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempf, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action on Licensees who are non-compliant with the Oklahoma Tax Commission:

Nancy Bryant, SP#458 and Amber Diaz, SP#3274

Ms. Hall addressed the Board concerning Nancy Bryant and Amber Diaz not being tax compliant, but they did make timely renewal of their license for 2015. Dr. Hudson moved and Dr. Krempf seconded the motion to table the renewal of Nancy Bryant and Amber Diaz until next Board meeting. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempf, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action on FY 2016 contract with Office of the Attorney General.

Dr. Krempf moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to approve the contract for legal services for FY16. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempf, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible action on Administrative Assistant position.

Ms. Hall discussed with the Board regarding the position of the Administrative Assistant. OMES originally told us that the Administrative Assistant position, to be eligible for benefits, was 16 hours a week but we were misinformed and that position actually needs to work 20 hours a week. Ms. Hall discussed with the Board that at the time we did our budget we under budgeted the cost in payroll making us short in funds in that area but that we had over budgeted in other area. The Board decided to setup a meeting with OMES to discuss options to fix current budget and do a budget revision. Ms. Grammer requested that Ms. Hall to do a needs analysis for the office. Table till next Board meeting.

Discussion and Possible action on meeting with Department of Education.

Ms. Grammer and Ms. Balzer discussed the meeting between themselves, Ms. McHugh, Renee Aczel from Department of Ed and Mona Ryan from training program for assistants, regarding issues related to licensure and the certificate that slpa's get from department of education to make sure all departments are on the same page and to help make process flow easier. The Board is on the right track and there are no conflicts at this time. No motion needed.

Discussion and Possible Action on Financial Reports.

Ms. Hall reviewed the financial reports from February 2015 and March 2015. No action needed.

Review and Possible Action on Submission of Executive Director's P-Card Statement for Review and Approval.

Dr. Krempl moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to approve the Executive Directors P-card statement for February 2015 and March 2015. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson and Dr. Krempl all voted affirmatively with a show of hands. Motion approved.
