FUNDAMENTAL AREA

Completion of at least 75 semester credit hours from one or more colleges or universities that reflect a well-integrated program of study dealing with (a) the biological/physical sciences and mathematics, (b) the behavioral and/or social sciences, including normal aspects of human behavior and communication, and the nature, prevention, evaluation, and treatment of speech, language, hearing, and related disorders. Some course work must address issues pertaining to normal and abnormal human development and behavior across the life span and to culturally diverse populations. At least twenty-seven (27) of the 75 semester credit hours must be in Basic Science Course Work. At least thirty-six (36) of the 75 semester credit hours must be in Professional Course Work.

(A) Basic Science Course Work. Applicants must earn at least twenty-seven (27) credit hours in the basic sciences. At least six (6) semester credit hours must be in the biological/physical sciences and mathematics. At least six (6) semester hours must be in the behavioral and/social sciences. At least fifteen (15) semester credit hours must be in the basic human communication processes, to include course work in each of the following three areas of speech, language, and hearing: the anatomic and physiologic bases, the physical and psychophysical bases, and the linguistic, and psycholinguistic and cultural aspects.
