OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – February 2016 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

Unemployment rates continue to rise in most Oklahoma counties in February

Unemployment rates rose in 68 of the state's 77 counties in February. **McIntosh County** again recorded Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 8.7 percent. **Latimer County** and **Haskell County** contributed the second and third highest rates for the month respectively. **Cimarron County** posted the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.4 percent. **Beaver County** claimed the second lowest rate, while **Grant and Woods counties** tied for the month's third lowest county rate. Four counties saw unemployment rate drops.


