Unemployment rates down in 75 of Oklahoma's 77 counties for September 2010

In September, **Latimer and McCurtain counties** shared Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 10.4 percent. **LeFlore and Sequoyah counties** tied for the second highest rate, and **Okmulgee County** claimed sole possession of the month's third highest county rate. **Beaver County** reported the state's lowest county rate again at 3.0 percent. **Harper and Roger Mills counties** rounded out the three lowest county rates for September 2010.


