OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – October 2015 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

Unemployment rates up for more than one-third of Oklahoma counties in October

In October, **McIntosh and Latimer Counties** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 7.8 percent. **Haskell County** had the second highest rate for the month, while **Coal County** reported the state's third highest rate. **Cimarron County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.0 percent. Unemployment rates increased over the month in 30 of 77 counties.


