A Meeting of the Board of Examiners of Psychologists was held at 9:00 a.m., on Thursday, March 22, 2018, at the Colcord Center, 421 NW 13th Street, Suite 180, Oklahoma City, OK 73103.

Announcement and Introduction:

Dr. Roberson announced that a quorum was present to conduct business. He confirmed with Ms. Rose that the meeting was filed with the Secretary of State and the agenda was posted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act.

Statement of the Mission of the Oklahoma State Board of Examiners of Psychologists:

After discussion, Mr. Shirley recommended that the Board not adopt the proposed changes to 575:1-1-3, adopt the proposed changes to 575:1-1-4, as amended; and adopt all changes to Chapter 10, as proposed. *Dr. Ward made a motion to accept the recommendation. Mr. O'Connor seconded the motion and the motion passed. Ward, Howard, O'Connor, Randleman, and Roberson voted for the motion.*

Dr. Howard made a motion to adjourn. Dr. Randleman seconded the motion and the motion passed. Ward, Howard, O'Connor, Randleman, and Roberson voted for the motion.
