


ORDINANCE NO.: 2006-1



An Ordinance extending the corporate boundaries of the Town of Laverne, Oklahoma, as to include the following described tract of real estate, and making the same subject to the jurisdiction thereof and declaring an emergency;

WHEREAS, **Dan A. Crocker and Lynda L. Crocker**, husband and wife, are the owners of the following described real estate, to-wit:

A tract of land in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE/4SW/4) of Section 28, Township 26 North, Range 25 WIM, Harper County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of said Section 28; thence North 00°49'26" East 1064.00 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence North 89°57'31" West a distance of 150.00 feet; thence North 00°49'26" East a distance of 150.00 feet; thence South 89°57'31" East a distance of 150.00 feet; thence South 00°49'26" West a distance of 150.00 feet to the Point of Beginning; said tract containing 0.52 acres, more or less.

(Said real estate is designated as Tract #1 on the plat attached to the Joint Tenancy Warranty Deed dated March 13, 2002; filed March 18, 2002; and recorded in Book 572 at Page 194 of the records of the Harper County Clerk.)

AND WHEREAS, it appearing to the Board of Trustees of the said Town of Laverne, Oklahoma, that all statutory requirements and notices have been completed and are all in due and legal form;


AND WHEREAS, said Town of Laverne, Oklahoma, in its discretion and within its jurisdiction deems it proper to increase said town limits for the benefit of said municipality.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LAVERNE, HARPER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, in regular session assembled:

(1) That the above tract of land as designated be and the same is hereby annexed to and made a part of the Town of Laverne, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of the Town of Laverne, Oklahoma, be and are hereby extended so as to include said tract and the same is hereby made a part of and included within the corporate limits of said Town, and fully subject to the jurisdiction thereof. The final service plan is by reference incorporated herein and made a part of this Ordinance.

(2) EMERGENCY CLAUSE: An emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason of which it is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety and welfare, and for the best interest of the public, that this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication, according to law.
